

INTRODUCTION OF SKZ

In Pakistan, a significant part of our population, faces daily challenges in slums, where access to basic necessities is a daily struggle. With 20 million of the population residing in slums, countless families face challenges ranging from inadequate housing to limited access to healthcare and education. Alarming statistics according to a PIDE study report reveals that Pakistan has the world's second-highest number of out-of-school children with about 26 million children aged five to sixteen not attending school in the country. At SKZ Foundation, we're on a mission to change this narrative.

SKZ Foundation is currently operating 4 schools, 1

in Punjab and 3 in Gilgit Baltistan where more than

500 underprivileged children are getting quality

education, Registered in both Pakistan and UK

under Charity Commission for England and

Wales, Voluntary Social Welfare Agencies

Registration and Control Ordinance of 1961.

Societies Registration Act of 1860 and the

Companies Act of 2017.

In 2017, the journey of SKZ Foundation began with a humble initiative—a small hut where slum children were given the gift of education. This

grassroots effort quickly gained momentum, resonating with the shared vision of providing quality education to underserved communities. However, in 2020, the journey faced an unexpected obstacle with the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, disrupting the regular operations. Despite the challenges, SKZ Foundation remained resilient and in March 2021.

a significant milestone was achieved, the establishment of first SKZ Model School in Sabzazar Lahore. This resilient initiative provided a beacon of hope during challenging times, offering quality education to children in a structured and sefe environment. The success of the SKZ Model School fueled the foundation's commitment to extending its impact.

In the same year, SKZ Foundation expanded its

reach to the picturesque landscapes of Gilgit Baltistan Thamacho, establishing a school to bring education closer to deserving communi-

ties. The commitment continued to grow in 2022 with the establishment of schools in Arnicho and Prono GB, marking milestones in SKZ Foundation's mission to bridge educational gaps and uplift communities. These schools are currently providing education to more than 500

deserving students.

As SKZ Foundation forges ahead, the vision remains clear: to transform lives through education and create lasting impacts in communities that need it most. The journey, born in a simple hut, has evolved into a network of schools, symbolizing the foundation's decication to building a brighter future for children in every corner of the country.

FLOOD RELIEF CAMPAIGN

SKZ accomplished a commendable feat by actively engaging in flood relief efforts from June to October. With thousands of homes destroyed or rendered uninhabitable, the organization swiftly mobilized resources to provide medical aid and food supplies.

Food Supplies:

SKZ ensured that affected families were safely looked after and the distribution of food was carried out in an efficient manner. Already assembled ration packs comprising of basic necessities were handed over to individuals and the families.

Medical Camps:

In addition to food, SKZ set up medical camps and mobile clinics, delivering primary healthcare services, vaccinations, and medicines to those in need. We provided hygiene kits, health sessions, food packs and stationary for kids. We prioritized the healthcare needs of the flood-affected communities. The NGO actively collaborated with medical professionals and volunteers to provide much-needed medical supplies and support.

Stationary for Kids:

SKZ, in addition to their ongoing efforts, also distributed stationery to the children affected by the flood. This initiative was undertaken with the aim of ensuring that the devastating flood does not hinder their pursuit of education. By providing them with necessary stationery supplies, SKZ aims to support these children in maintaining their access to education and empowering them to overcome the challenges caused by the flood.


















CLEAN WATER PROJECT




In Cholistan, DG Khan, Rahim Yar Khan, Sukkur & Tharparkar

In May and June, 2022 SKZ delivered clean water and food packages to approximately 5000 vulnerable individuals across the regions of Cholistan, DG Khan, Rahim Yar Khan, Sukkur, and Tharparkar. This accomplishment marks a substantial step towards alleviating the suffering of those grappling with water scarcity and food insecurity in these areas. Leveraging their extensive network and resources, SKZ mobilized a dedicated team of volunteers, aid workers, and logistics experts to execute this mission effectively.

These water cans traversed the arid landscapes of Cholistan, DG Khan, Rahim Yar Khan, Sukkur, and Tharparkar, delivering clean and potable water directly to the doorsteps of communities in need. This initiative not only quenched the thirst of thousands but also helped mitigate the risks associated with waterborne diseases.













WINTER CLOTH DRIVE



In Sindh, Punjab, KPK & Gilgit Baltistan.

To combat the biting cold, the foundation distributed a wide range of warm clothing items to 100 people. These included jackets, sweaters, shawls, blankets, gloves, hats, and socks. Each item was carefully selected to provide maximum warmth and protection against the harsh winter conditions. This was our post flood campaign project.

The distribution process was conducted with great care and attention to ensure that the winter clothing reached those who needed it the most. We set up distribution centers in various locations across Mithi (Tharparker), Rajanpur and Peshawar strategically located to cater to the needs of the local communities. Trained volunteers and ald workers were deployed to facilitate the smooth and efficient distribution of the winter clothing items.

The Winter Drive by the SKZ not only provided physical warmth but also instilled a sense of comfort and relief among the recipients. Many individuals and families who struggle to afford adequate winter clothing were able to stay warm and protected during the cold winter months, thanks to the efforts of SKZ.









PLANTATION DRIVE

If you plant a tree, you plant a life

In Pakistan, according to the World Wildlife Fund (WWF), only 4.54 million hectares of land are currently covered by forests. Regrettably, the nation faces the second-highest deforestation rate in Asia, surpassed only by Afghanistan. This alarming statistic falls significantly below the recommended forest cover for a country of this scale.

Recognizing the urgent need for action, the SKZ Foundation has taken the initiative to alter this concerning narrative. Through various organized tree planting drives across different cities, the foundation aims to counteract the deforestation trend and contribute to the restoration of a healthier and more sustainable environment.

Through organized plantation drives, SKZ has encouraged the students of SKZ Model School to actively participate in this crucial initiative, imparting valuable lessons about planting trees for the environment. Recognizing the pivotal role that trees play in maintaining a balanced ecosystem, students are being informed about the crucial role of tree planting and how it significantly contributes to the well-being of the environment.

By instilling a sense of responsibility and knowledge about the vital role of plants, SKZ Foundation aims to contribute to a greener and healthier Pakistan.






SKZ Song Launching Ceremony
