These two years been filled with significant milestones, impactful initiatives, and inspiring collaborations that have propelled our mission forward.

"In the slums, I found hunger not just for food but for hope and understanding, with no knowledge of religion and life. This inspired me to combine sustenance with education and spiritual insight" It was my dream to provide education to the children living in slums, and it all began with a humble tent setup. By the grace of Allah SWT, our schools now serve over 500 students, empowering them with knowledge and opportunities for a brighter future.





# INTRODUCTION OF SKZ

In Pakistan, a significant part of our population, faces daily challenges in slums, where access to basic necessities is a daily struggle. With 20 million of the population residing in slums, countless families face challenges ranging from inadequate housing to limited access to healthcare and education. Alarming statistics according to a PIDE study report reveals that Pakistan has the world's second-highest number of out-of-school children with about 26 million children aged five to sixteen not attending school in the country. At SKZ Foundation, we're on a mission to change this narrative.

SKZ Foundation is currently operating 4 schools, 1

in Punjab and 3 in Gilgit Baltistan where more than

500 underprivileged children are getting quality

education. Registered in both Pakistan and UK

under Charity Commission for England and

Wales, Voluntary Social Welfare Agencies

Registration and Control Ordinance of 1961.

Societies Registration Act of 1860 and the

Companies Act of 2017.

In 2017, the journey of SKZ Foundation began with a humble initiative—a small hut where slum children were given the gift of education. This

grassroots effort quickly gained momentum, resonating with the shared vision of providing quality education to underserved communities. However, in 2020, the journey faced an unexpected obstacle with the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, disrupting the regular operations. Despite the challenges, SKZ Foundation remained resilient and in March 2021.

a significant milestone was achieved, the establishment of first SKZ Model School in Sabzazar Lahore. This resilient initiative provided a beacon of hope during challenging times, offering quality education to children in a structured and sefe environment. The success of the SKZ Model School fueled the foundation's commitment to extending its impact.

In the same year, SKZ Foundation expanded its

reach to the picturesque landscapes of Gilgit Baltistan Thamacho, establishing a school to bring education closer to deserving communi-

ties. The commitment continued to grow in 2022 with the establishment of schools in Arnicho and Prono GB, marking milestones in SKZ Foundation's mission to bridge educational gaps and uplift communities. These schools are currently providing education to more than 500

deserving students.

As SKZ Foundation forges ahead, the vision remains clear: to transform lives through education and create lasting impacts in communities that need it most. The journey, born in a simple hut, has evolved into a network of schools, symbolizing the foundation's decication to building a brighter future for children in every corner of the country.

# WINTER CLOTH DRIVE


#### In Sindh, Punjab, KPK & Gilgit Baltistan.

To combat the biting cold, the foundation distributed a wide range of warm clothing items to 100 people. These included jackets, sweaters, shawls, blankets, gloves, hats, and socks. Each item was carefully selected to provide maximum warmth and protection against the harsh winter conditions. This was our post flood campaign project.

The distribution process was conducted with great care and attention to ensure that the winter clothing reached those who needed it the most. We set up distribution centers in various locations across Mithi (Tharparker), Rajanpur and Peshawar strategically located to cater to the needs of the local communities. Trained volunteers and aid workers were deployed to facilitate the smooth and efficient distribution of the winter clothing items.

The Winter Drive by the SKZ not only provided physical warmth but also instilled a sense of comfort and relief among the recipients. Many individuals and families who struggle to afford adequate winter clothing were able to stay warm and protected during the cold winter months, thanks to the efforts of SKZ.





## **FOOD DRIVE**

Expanding our outreach, SKZ Foundation organized a Food Drive to support both the slum community and the students at SKZ Model School. Recognizing the widespread issue of food insecurity, we distributed essential provisions to alleviate hunger and enhance well-being. These bags contained essential food items to sustain them beyond Ramadan, reaffirming our dedication to alleviating hunger and supporting those in need, particularly during festive occasions.












## EID CELEBRATIONS


## INAUGRATION OF UPPER KACCHURA SCHOOL
